Policy and Procedure

Introduction & Context

It is the policy of Stanian Limited to seek to provide safe and healthy working conditions, to encourage safe working methods and to enlist the active help of all employees and Associates in achieving these ends. Public Sector Providers:

- accepts responsibility for the control of contractors working on its behalf and for the safety of other persons who come into direct contact with their operations
- accepts the responsibility, where appropriate, for ensuring that all fire precaution measures are taken to allow free access to emergency escape routes
- accepts responsibility for contractors and visitors whilst on the organisation's premises
- accepts the responsibility for providing necessary information and training required by employees

Stanian Limited expects every Associate and employee to take reasonable care of the health and safety of him/herself and all other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions and to co-operate with management in achieving a safe working environment.

It is the responsibility of all Associate Consultants and employees to ensure the health and safety of themselves and others by:-

- Working within relevant legal requirements regarding health and safety
- Bringing to the notice of the client anything they see which may endanger the health and safety of themselves or others
- Abiding by the relevant health and safety policies of the client which are relevant to them
- Reporting all accidents, whether persons are injured or not
- Reporting all hazards, potential hazards or persons creating hazards
